This month, Pastor Tim will talk about how much it helps our hearts to be thankful. Listen carefully for all of the ways Paul focused on God's goodness—and how his gratitude brought him joy.

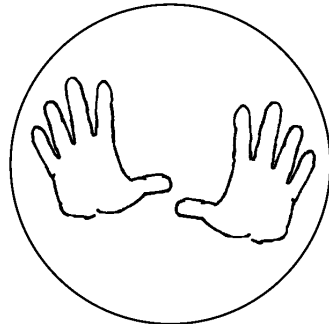
