When we read the Book of Psalms, we get to see David's heart for God. And what did David know about God? Because of his faith, David knew a God who was a shepherd to His people and who redeemed them of their sins. He knew a God who was a guide to the Israelites, and a Savior of lives and souls. When you add all those things together, it looks a lot like Jesus!
